## Children's Learning Center

The Children's Learning Center (CLC) at Bristol Mountain, is located in the Sunset Lodge on the main floor just as you enter the building from the parking lot. There is a convenient drop off and pick up area in front of Sunset Lodge making it easy for parents to unload the car and then park!

Registration for junior classes in the CLC is located inside the entrance of the building. Parents can purchase tickets, rentals, and lessons for the whole family, not just for the child who will be taking the lesson.

The CLC lessons are offered daily and you can register your child for single or multiple lessons each day. If your child is staying for two consecutive classes, we offer the convenience of supervision and lunch or snacks between lesson times. Parents can continue to ski or snowboard without having to return to the CLC during that time frame.

Children are grouped by age and ability level with a small instructor to student ratio. The CLC also has its own ski and snowboard rental area for children participating in lessons. This eliminates parents and children having to go to the Equipment Rental Center for the child's skis or snowboard.

For kids, the CLC ski and snowboard instructors are the best! They are kid-friendly and enthusiastic about teaching kids! Our instructors love winter and look forward to sharing their skiing and snowboarding skills with your child! More than just a lesson, introducing young skiers and riders to the mountain environment, safety, fun, and learning is what it's all about.

At the end of class, the children get to enjoy a long-awaited cup of hot chocolate while their parents review their child's progress with their instructor. Progress cards are given to parents to help track their child's improvement throughout the winter.



## Lesson Schedule

Lessons are offered for all levels, from first timers, who want to see what the excitement is all about through advanced levels for kids who want to be superstars! We incorporate safety, fun, and learning into our program with a strong emphasis on:

## Registration

Upon arriving at Bristol Mountain, parents and children register in the Children's Learning Center.

Registration begins one hour prior to the start of the lesson time and ends 30 minutes prior to the start of the scheduled class lesson.

Supervision is provided from the registration time until the start of the lesson.

Parents must pick up children in the Children's Learning Center immediately following the completion of their lesson.

## Your Responsibility Code

1. Always stay in control and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
2. People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
3. You must not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
4. Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
5. Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
6. Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
7. Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride, and unload safely.
