

## CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

### Weeski, Ages 5-7

For intermediate skiers capable of skiing all intermediate (blue square) terrain. Must be able to ride the Sunset, Morning Star, and Comet Express chairlifts without supervision. Rate reflects a smaller class size of six or fewer. Snowboarding excluded. Daily class lessons offered for beginners in this age group.

### Junior, Ages 8-18

Join a friend or make new ones. The Junior Brigade accepts all ability levels from the beginner to advanced for either skiing or snowboarding.

### Forerunners, Ages 8-18

Advanced to expert skiers, Forerunners is an introduction to the fundamentals of ski racing as well as personal skiing development. The season concludes with participation in the Bristol Mountain Race Club Championships. Trophies are awarded to all age groups for boys and girls. Race Park Pass included.

### Mogulrunners, Ages 8-18

Part of the Freestyle Team introducing intermediate and advanced skiers to freestyle skiing. Regular competition is not included, but if participants develop an interest in competing in local events, the Freestyle Team staff will provide coaching at those events.

### Parkrunners, Ages 8-18

Introduces intermediate through advanced skiers and snowboarders to the technical and tactical aspects of terrain park features. Park safety and etiquette are stressed. Instruction in flat terrain and mogul skiing included.

### Mountainrunners, Ages 8-18

Advanced to expert skiers and snowboarders inclusive of moguls, racing, terrain park, and just plain skiing and snowboarding. Designed for the adventurer who desires to expand his/her skills. Race Park Pass included.

### Adult, Ages 19+

Offered to ski and snowboard levels from beginner to advanced. Ski fast, ski slow, take a break when you want and express-line it to the summit. A great way to meet others with the same interests.

### Ladies, Ages 19+

The perfect mid-week outdoor solution for ladies. Open to beginner through experienced skiers (snowboard classes held with sufficient interest). Activities may include: introduction to Nordic skiing or NASTAR racing, an excursion to the Morning Star Cafe, and a season-finale cookout.

## BRIGADE POLICIES

1. The enclosed Bristol Mountain Assumption of All Risks Agreement as well as the Parent Agreement, for participants under the age of 19, must be signed prior to the first day of class. The absence of the completed Agreement will prohibit participation in class.

2. Non-pass holder purchasers will be issued a Brigade season pass valid on the day of each scheduled class as well as the make-up day offered the week following the conclusion of scheduled classes. Brigade season passes are issued in the Guest Services Office during business hours prior to the first day of Brigades. Executive and Student season pass holders will utilize their season pass during classes and are not issued a Brigade season pass.

3. Season passes must be worn above the waist and clearly visible to lift personnel at all times. Season passes are nontransferable. The falsification, forgery, or alteration of a season pass or the willful use or impersonation by anyone other than the pass holder is prohibited and will lead to arrest for theft of service. Bristol Mountain reserves the right to revoke a season pass for any reason.

4. Report a lost season pass to the Guest Services Office. Replacement cost is \$25. If the season pass is forgotten, a full-rate lift ticket must be purchased.

5. Classes are determined by age and skill level and range from 8 to 10 students. Weeski Brigade classes range from 6 to fewer students. Requests for placement with friends or a specific instructor are accommodated to the best of our ability on the first class day. Each group remains with the same instructor during of the program.

6. Participants must check in at the Snowsports School Information Desk in the Rocket Lodge from 8:30 am - 9:30 am on the first day of class.

7. Classes are held rain or shine. An announcement will be posted on the Facebook page if classes are cancelled due to severe weather.

8. A make-up day is scheduled the week following the completion of each program. Coaching is not provided during the make-up day.

9. A refund, in like manner, may be issued for any reason, minus a \$50 service charge provided a written request is submitted to the Administrative Office on or before October 1, 2016. Starting October 2nd, a Gift Card credit for the unused value of the Brigade season pass may be issued for a serious medical condition which prevents the pass holder from utilizing the pass for the remainder of the season. The amount of the Gift Card credit is prorated based on a schedule. Additional rules apply. Inquiries may be directed to (585) 374-1129.

## ASSUMPTION OF ALL RISKS AGREEMENT

I, \_\_\_\_\_, know and understand that Alpine, Nordic, and Free skiing, as well as, snowboarding and other snow activities, including games and competitive events, are activities that involve a significant risk of personal injury, death or property damage. I also know and understand that there are natural and environmental conditions and risks that independently, or in combination with these activities, may cause property damage, or severe or even fatal injuries to me or others. I understand that trail conditions vary constantly because of weather changes and skier use, and I also understand that the risks of skiing/riding also include terrain park elements, jumps, slide rails and other man made features, changing weather conditions, bare spots, variations in snow, ice, forest growth, other ground cover, surface and subsurface conditions, and terrain, bumps, moguls, rocks, debris, equipment and machinery on slopes, collisions with other skiers and snowboarders and natural and man made objects, and skier/snowboarder error.

I agree and acknowledge that I have made a voluntary choice to participate in these activities at Bristol Mountain with the risk that they present. In consideration of being permitted to participate in a ski or snowboard instructional program at Bristol Mountain, I agree to ASSUME ANY AND ALL RISK OF INJURY OR DEATH, which might be associated with, or result from, my participation in these activities. I agree to accept all responsibility for the risks, conditions and hazards which may occur whether they now be known or unknown.

I further agree that I will accept and abide by all rules and regulations of Bristol Mountain, as well as all obligations that may be imposed upon by Article 18 of the General Obligations Law or any other law of the State of New York.

I have fully read and understand this Agreement and all of its terms. I understand that this acknowledgement and assumption may affect my legal claims for damages in the event of my death or any injury to me. I nevertheless enter into this Agreement freely and voluntarily agree that it is a binding upon me, my heirs, assigns, and legal representatives.

I agree that the terms of this Agreement shall be binding and shall be governed by the laws of the State of New York and that the terms of this document shall be admissible in evidence as a binding legal document between me and the persons and entities listed above in this Agreement.
