On a clear day, a glimpse of Canandaigua Lake is visible from the summit.







- * Reservations are required for groups of 20 or more. Please call 585-374-1134 to book your group.
- * Online tickets not available day of sky ride.
- Children under 4 feet tall must be accompanied by an adult while riding the chairlift.
- Children ages 2 and younger must be adequately secured by a car seat or papoose carrier while riding the chairlift.
- Passengers must be able to get on and off the chairlift without assistance and must wear proper footwear to include sneakers, hiking boots or shoes.
- * Passengers will unload at the top of the lift and exit the ramp. You may reload the chair at the direction of the lift attendant. Waiting period to reload may vary depending on traffic.
- Visitors may ride the Comet Express from the summit to the base or hike down via recommended (marked) trails.
