#### FOLLOW THESE STEPS TO ORGANIZE YOUR TROOP OR PACK'S SCOUT NIGHT

ш	Decide on a date and notify your troop/pack and their friends and families.
	Communicate Bristol Mountain's Scout Night Polices and Responsibility Code to participants.
	Distribute waivers to anyone skiing or snowboarding during Scout Nights.
	Collect payment and waivers from troop/pack members.
	Get a count of the number of scouts and their family members who will require rentals (ski vs
	snowboard) and lessons (lesson time and ski vs snowboard).
	Turn in payment to pack/troop treasurer and receive a <b>Scout Check</b> made out to Bristol Mountain
	for the total amount or have one credit card available for payment.
	Complete order form and send in with payment and waivers to:

### **SCOUT NIGHT POLICIES**

- Orders must be received no later than December 22, 2021 for December visits and February 14,
   2022 for February visits.
- If packages are no longer available on the night you have chosen, we will try to accommodate your group on another night. If no other nights are available your payment will be returned.
- Personal checks, cash, or credit cards are not accepted from the group or Scout leader. Scout
   Troop/Pack checks or credit card are the only acceptable form of payment.
- This event is open to scouts and immediate family members ages 7 and older only.
  - Lift Tickets for those ages 6 and younger are free with a paying adult, however lessons are not available for this age group and rentals must be purchased separately.
- All packages must be pre-purchased. Packages are not sold on the night of the event.
- The cost for a Scout Night Package is \$45 and includes a lift ticket, beginner lesson, and equipment rental.
- Equipment rentals include skis, boots, and poles for skiers and boots and boards for snowboarders.
- Helmet rentals are available for the additional cost of \$6.
- The Beginner Class Lesson is 1 hour and will begin promptly at your scheduled lesson time either 4pm or 5:30pm at the Snowsports Meeting Place sign near the Comet Express Lift.
- This is a rain or shine event. Refunds are not offered under any circumstances.

### WARNING TO SKIERS/SNOWBOARDERS

- 1. Skiers, snowboarders, and lift passengers are governed by the New York State Safety in Skiing Code, Article 18 of the NYS General Obligations Law. Before affixing your pass or allowing any pass to be affixed to your person, your attention is directed to a posted "Warning to Skiers" that is displayed in the Guest Services Office. The Safety in Skiing Code requires you to seek out, read, and understand the "Warning to Skiers" before you decide to participate in the sport of skiing.
- 2. Skiing and snowboarding, like many other sports, contains inherent risks, including, but not limited to the risk of personal injury or death or property damage. Therefore, Bristol Mountain takes appropriate measures to protect skiers from undue, unnecessary, and unreasonable hazards, including those created by skier conduct, excesses, and attitudes. Skiers who create such hazards for themselves, or other skiers, can be arrested under Article 18 of the NYS General Obligations Law and may be required to leave the area. They will be denied skiing and snowboarding privileges at Bristol Mountain. In such case, no refund of purchase price for lift ticket or pass will be made.

### YOUR RESPONSIBILITY CODE

- 1. Always stay in control, be able to stop or avoid other people or objects
- 2. People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
- 3. You must not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
- 4. Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield to others
- 5. Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
- 6. Observe all posted signs and warnings.

- 7. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
- 8. Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride and unload safely.
